CREATING SAFER SCHOOL ZONES

The City of Norfolk has installed a total of 19 cameras around 10 Norfolk Public School locations as part of the school zone speed photo enforcement program. This program's goal is to increase driver compliance in the reduced speed zones while improving the safety of students in nearby schools. Camera activation began on March 4th with a 60-day warning period for drivers. Drivers caught speeding through the school zones during designated school hours will receive a \$100 fine after the warning period ends on May 3rd. 
WARD 3 Traffic Signal Box Art Work




